**Class Fees:**

Class listings indicate member and non-members class fees. Become a member and save! Membership forms are available in the office and on the website.

Class fees include all materials unless noted.

Class fees are not prorated and refunds are not issued for missed days.

**Registration Policy:**

Enrollment is on a first come first serve basis. To guarantee a place in any 1 class, tuition must be paid at the time of enrollment. Classes not meeting minimum enrollments will be cancelled and refunds or credits issued.

**Cancellation Policy:**

Tuition is NON-REFUNDABLE unless you have provided a written cancellation notice at least one week (7 days) prior to the start of the class. A \$5.00 handling fee will be charged on cancellations.

**Scholarship Program:**

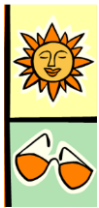
### **Wire Sculptures – 3 day class (Wed-Fri)**

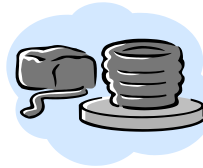
**Cultural Kaleidoscope:** Explore the art of different cultures and make art projects inspired by what we've learned.

Ages: 7 & up, 9:00 – 10:30 a.m. \$45/\$50



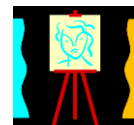
**Clay Play:** Mash it, roll it, pinch it and have fun in the clay play class.
